

Hello,

We had our center briefing today, and I wanted to inform you that your work has been acknowledged and that the center is proposing to develop regulations to ban the use of formaldehyde in hair smoothing products. To this end, the legal staff will look for how to go about implementing this new policy, and in the meantime, we will do the following:
