I just want to make sure that you are aware of the EWG lawsuit. They have sued the FDA for not taking action on the formaldehyde CP. again, we finished this project 6 months ago, wrote the safety review, had our briefing where the ban was agreed upon, reviewed the CP and gave it to ORPSS to provide the response that they want, based on our reviews. we were done with this project a long ago and we have nothing to do with the lawsuit. This lawsuit is 100% the property of CFSAN and OCC and whoever else is above us. Women's Voices for the Earth is the next lawsuit. Our review and conclusions have been documented and our support for any outreach material has been sent to OFVM. The approach decided by CFSAN (dear manufacturer letter, guidance and outreach for the mandatory warning statement), while not responding to the CP, is not a good one, but that is just my opinion.

Anyway, I wanted to make you aware that the CPs are coming back to haunt us, because we don't respond to them. I also feel bad that we are responding next week to the PCPC CP, while we are neglecting the CPs from NGOs. The formaldehyde CP from EWG also came to us in 2011 I think. Again, my opinion.
