What are the minimum number of units requested-

FDA collected three (3) 10 1 fl oz bottles of the GK Hair System with Juvexin Curly and Resistant hair smooth products (Sample 849412; WL) At least 30 3 fluid oz are required for formaldehyde analysis Collect that amount with the minimum number volume units possible

What would be the minimum size bottle that could be purchased -

Based upon previous FDA analysis at least 30 3 fluid oz should be collected For product packaged in 10 oz bottle, 3 bottles should be collected Two bottles may be collected for products packaged in 16 fluid oz - 18 fluid A single bottle is required for 32 oz bottle (See table)
