Dear Mr. Cluderay:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request seeking "(1) All shared or public calendar entries with the FCC Office of General Counsel [OGC] or any of the FCC commissioners' offices listing all meetings with CTIA[® -- the Wireless Association] employees and representatives regarding the [City of San Francisco Cell Phone Right-to-Know] [O]rdinance and related litigation; and (2) All e-mail or written correspondence to or from CTIA employees and representatives concerning the ordinance and related litigation."

We searched for records as of September 17, 2010, the date your request was received. See 47 C.F.R. § 0.461(f)(6). Enclosed are meeting schedulers and copies of the handouts received by OGC staff at one of the meetings. Other attachments noted on some of these documents are publicly available and are not provided to you. ¹ If you wish copies of these documents, please let us know.

You have been classified as an "all others" FOIA requester, entitling you to two free hours search and review time, and the first 100 pages free of copying charges. 47 C.F.R. § 0.470(a)(3)(i). Because we missed the October 18, 2010 deadline for processing your request, no search fees may be charged. 47 C.F.R. § 0.470(a)(3)(ii). Fewer than 100 pages are being provided to you, and therefore no copying fees will be assessed.

If you consider this to be a denial of your FOIA request, you may seek review by filing an application for review with the Office of General Counsel within 30 days of the date of this letter. 47 C.F.R. § 0.461(j).
