- 1 THE WITNESS: Well, in general, that's all related
- 2 to this 19- -- year 1995, a research of chromium
- 3 contamination relationship with human health. In
- 4 general, that's the nature of that -- all the phone
- 5 conversation.
- 6 And the -- they are a couple of times that this
- 7 is what I reported in this two days, that there are some
- 8 times of discussing other mistreated issues, but also
- 9 mistreated issues related to this project.
- 10 BY MR. TATRO:
- 11 Q From time to time in the conversations, was
- 12 Dr. Zhang asked to provide information?
- 13 A Oh, sure, a lot of times.
- 14 O And did he do so?
- 15 A He always -- I would say he always give some
- 16 insert or he make some effort, report those effort. It
- 17 was not always successful for him to look for the
- 18 information that ChemRisk asked for because a lot of
- 19 those information were just not maintained, and I
- 20 understand it's quite hard.
- Because in Dr. Zhang's time in China, my
- 22 understanding in 1960 and 1970, Dr. Zhang never had a

- 23 computer. All of this information were handwriting and
- 24 he's -- handwriting documents in his holding and --
- 25 and -- and I -- I was quite a -- impressed by how much
