In reference to our recent telephone convenetion, I would like to further discuss the incident wherein two of our plant personnel were exposed to hot Arachier (1248) vapors generated by a broken pipe connection. For your information and records the two men developed symtoms of tiepetitis as you predicted and were confined to a hospital for approximately two weeks.

In view of the above experience which has given me considerable concern i felt that the matter should be brought to your attention. Since we are dealing with a highly taxic material at high temperatures and since these fallures cannot be prevented, it is felt that a more thorough and clearly written description of the hazards be described under Safety of Handling. Also the antidate or first aid treatment if any be included. I certainly would be interested in this information if available.

I trust that this matter will be given your serious consideration so that other or new users are fully aware of the problem.

Thank you for your essistance in this incident and would appreciate hearing your views on the above.
