In preparation for our meeting this afternoon, we are transmitting the results of our research concerning whether the hydraulic fracturing process constitutes a discharge to the waters of New York State. As you will see, we do not believe that hydraulic fracturing is jurisdictional under the SPDES program because of the fact that the injection process is a carefully engineered process that occurs well below the groundwater zone in New York State. That fact together with the extensive casing and comenting requirements in New York State, preclude the release of hydraulic fracturing fluids to the waters of New York State, which is consistent with the experience in New York State and elsewhere.
